

## Crossing of Lake Baikal — Detailed description

Trip Length: 7    Group: 4-8    Departure: Fixed    Period: February - March

### Trip overview

For all those who want not only to see Baikal in winter, but also to try themselves at real ice trekking, we offer the "Baikal Crossing" tour.

A route awaits you, connecting 2 regions and 2 shores of Lake Baikal. Ice caves, rocky shores and the main attractions of the western shore of Lake Baikal: Olkhon Island, Maloye More Bay, Cape Burkhan and Cape Khoboy. Then the passage of the lake in its geographical center, above the thickness of ice covering the deepest point of Lake Baikal. Having reached the eastern coast, we will find ourselves in the protected territory of the Republic of Buryatia.

Travel in a small group accompanied by an experienced guide. For your comfort: only individual transport, second-class train tickets, three meals a day. For safety: accident insurance, crampons for walking on ice.

! No special preparation is required. The participant must be in good physical shape.

## Note

The tour price is valid for a group of 5 people. For smaller groups, the tour price is recalculated: - Group of 4: tour price - 245,500 rubles. For individual tourists and groups of 2-3 people, price upon request. The price is fixed in rubles. Ice walking crampons are provided to each participant. The price includes a train ticket Ulan-Ude - Irkutsk (2nd class). If you are traveling with your family or a group, you can choose convenient dates (upon request).

## Checklist & Equipment

You will need in Russia in winter:

- to protect yourself from the cold weather;
- to protect yourself from the wind;
- to protect your feet from moisture;
- to protect yourself from the sun's reflection from ice and snow.

Allow the system of "three layers":

- The first layer, called "second skin", determines the performance of the other two layers. It will transport sweat to the next layer and dry quickly to avoid cooling after exercise. Therefore forget the cotton retains moisture in the skin and choose underwear in synthetic fabrics.
- The second layer must keep the heat of the body as long as possible. Warm synthetic or mixed (wool or fleece turtleneck sweater) fabrics, that dry quickly, are preferable.
- The third layer should protect you against wind and moisture. Choose a jacket, long enough, 100% waterproof, preferably with hood.

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## Recommended checklist

underwear, socks (several pairs)  
T-shirts, shorts  
rubber slippers  
swimsuit / swim trunks  
trekking telescopic poles  
winter (down) jacket and warm pants (windproof and waterproof) / winter suit  
thermal underwear  
comfortable winter boots (suitable for walking on ice and snow)  
fleece jacket/sweater with collar  
warm mittens (for convenience, thin gloves and a second layer of mittens with fur) / ski gloves  
thermal socks  
comfortable warm hat and scarf (snood)  
moisturizing cream

## Meals

If you are a vegetarian or have any particular preferences, please let us know, so we could adapt the menu.

## Visa

You need a tourist visa to travel to Russia. It can be issued for a maximum period of 30 days. Your passport has to be valid for at least six months after the expiry date of your visa and to have at least two blank pages.

BaikalNature offers visa support and has created "BaikalNature letter of invitation" package. If you buy a BaikalNature tour, this package is absolutely free; when you buy any other BaikalNature service, you will have to pay for this package.

For questions regarding obtaining an electronic visa, please contact your tour manager.

## Money

The Russian currency is ruble. The cost of travel and other services is always fixed in rubles. Please note that cards from foreign banks do not work in Russia at the moment. Tourists can obtain a bank card from a Russian bank in advance or travel with cash. If you have euros or dollars with you, exchange offices will allow you to change them easily in the cities. It is also worth noting that the exchange rate at airports is usually not the most favorable. It is better to exchange in big cities (you can check the current exchange rate online). Important! Only new banknotes without defects or any traces are accepted for exchange.

## Tipping

All persons who compose the BaikalNature travel team (guides, drivers, cooks, etc.) are paid a decent wage for their services and do not expect any tips from you. So you have no obligation to leave anything. If you really want to express your satisfaction by leaving a gratuity, and if it is in foreign currency, be aware that torn or glued coins and banknotes cannot be exchanged. Anyway, thank you for your tips, left at your discretion in envelopes.

## Health

You need to get a health examination before a great trip. Consult your doctor. Get a dental checkup. If you have health problems that could worsen during the trip, make sure you have taken all your medications with you.

Provide a first aid kit that includes among other items:

- aspirin or paracetamol,
- anti-diarrheal pills,
- antiseptic,
- adhesive plaster,
- sterile pads.

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If you have individual diseases, make sure you have taken your medications.

You should be physically fit enough for this tour.
